

## Skirt Project Guidelines

The Creative Skirt Project challenges students to apply their creativity and technical skills to design, draft, and construct a unique skirt based on the notebooks and textbooks. This project will be a part of the Fashion Design Program Entry Review.

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### Design Guidelines:

- Must be a symmetrical design.
- Must have a waist finish and closure (straight waistband, with hook and bar, contoured waistband with hook and bar, or a facing with a smaller hook and eye above the zipper) and a lapped zipper
- Must have a machine finished rolled hem
- Side seam finished with Bound/HongKong seam treatment
- Skirt design incorporates a new design element either from notebook or textbook, and the design is creative and challenging

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### Submission

Student will work on skirt designs and submit three final skirt designs in flat drawing (front and back views) to be included in the digital submission. One design will be selected in consultation with the instructor (if the student is enrolled in ADES 1560). The student will then produce the full production pattern and construct the prototype in muslin fabric for the final submission.

Using your digital device, upload a PDF file including images of the three skirt designs, full production pattern, direction card, skirt prototype in all views. Please refer to the Creative Skirt Digital Submission Template for more details.
