The University of North Texas is excited to announce the **North Texas Promise** program. Beginning Fall 2026, qualifying first-time freshmen seeking their first bachelor's degree will have the **full cost of their tuition and mandatory fees covered** by a combination of federal, state and institutional grants and scholarships for up to four years (eight semesters).

Students who meet the following criteria will **automatically be considered** for North Texas Promise:



Be a Texas resident graduating from a Texas high school



Have a total family income of \$100,000 or less\*



Rank in Top 25% of high school class OR be eligible for Federal Pell Grant



Be admitted for the Fall 2026 semester by Feb. 15, 2026



Complete and have a valid FAFSA submitted to UNT by Feb.15, 2026

\*Total family income is determined via the FAFSA. Eligibility requires financial need as determined via the FAFSA. Funding is capped at financial need.

## Additional Eligibility

Enroll full-time\* at UNT in the fall semester after your high school graduation



Maintain full-time\* enrollment at UNT in fall and spring semesters

\*12 semester credit hours each fall and spring term = full-time enrollment
