Minors for Art History Majors:

While a foreign language is recommended as the minor, particularly for students who anticipate pursuing graduate studies in Art History, students may select another minor. Regardless of minor chosen, all art history majors are required to complete four semesters of foreign language (1010, 1020, 2040, 2050).

Graduation Requirements: 18 hours (including 12 advanced hours) must be completed at UNT. 42 hours must be advanced; 24 of the 42 advanced hours must be completed at UNT. Minimum 2.0 GPA (UNT and overall). **Grades of C or better are required for all CVAD requirements.**

Senior Seminar Course for Art History Majors

Art History majors must successfully complete Senior Seminar (ARTH 4848) in order to graduate. Students must have successfully completed Art History Methodologies (ARTH 4800) in order to register for Senior Seminar. Art History Methodologies and Senior Seminar are both offered in fall semesters only.

Students interested in the Art History grad track option leading to the Art History MA begin by following the Art History degree program. Additional information is provided in ARTH 4800, required as part of the Art History degree.

Art History Graduate Track Pathway

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. 75 credit hours completed and minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5, including
 - 15 hours of advanced art history at UNT with a GPA in these courses of 3.5 or better
 - completion of the undergraduate foreign language requirement
- 2. ARTH 4800 with a grade of A

After completing ARTH 4800, students may apply to the Department. Application Requirements:

- 1. an official transcript
- 2. statement of purpose
- 3. two letters of recommendation from art history department faculty members

Important Note: Students who do not have an official degree plan on file before the semester they plan to graduate <u>may not</u> apply for graduation.
