**Note:** For all students pursuing majors and minors within the College of Visual Arts and Design (CVAD), a 2.5 grade point average is required in all art courses. Additionally, a grade of C or above must be earned in all CVAD required courses — completed in residence or transferred to UNT — to be considered for credit toward a CVAD degree. A grade of D or below will not satisfy any art-based course requirements, electives or prerequisites.
